Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top **<u>8 qualifiers and ties</u>** will move on to the championship proper at the Wianno Club on October 4-5, 2021. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2019 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the <u>Mass Golf Hard Card</u>. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Policies & Procedures: Please refer to the Mass Golf Policies & Procedures.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - <u>\$20.00</u> (*Cash and/or Credit accepted*). Caddies and push/pull carts are permitted.

Starting Times: Play will begin at 8:00 AM, in groups of three, at ten-minute intervals, off the 1st tee. Please be sure to be at your starting tee <u>at least 10 minutes prior</u> to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,000 yards (WHITE/BLUE Tees).

Practice Rounds: Competitors are encouraged to call the Pro Shop at (508) 764-6290 to schedule their practice round tee time. Practice Rounds are available to competitors <u>Monday - Tuesday</u> and are based on the Club's availability. Competitors will be required to pay a mandatory trail fee of <u>\$20.00</u> for their practice round.

Club Facilities: The golf shop and clubhouse will be available at 7:00 AM.

Food & Beverage: Breakfast services will **NOT** be available to competitors. Lunch will be available from the Club at the player's expense (*Cash and/or Credit accepted*).

Practice Range: Will be open and available at 7:00 AM.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's Mass Golf/USGA Handicap Index by the Mass Golf staff.

Scoring: Paper scorecards will be used as the official scoring method for Super Senior Amateur Qualifying.
