Format: 54 holes, stroke play (18-holes per day), 150 +/- players, comprised of qualified and those exempt from qualifying. The fifty (50) lowest scorers & ties or anyone within 7 strokes of the leader after 36-holes will continue play on June 14th.

Rules of Play: The 2023 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the [Mass Golf Hard Card](#). The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the Championship sites. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Terms of the Competition.

Golf Carts, Caddies and Pull Carts: Players may use caddies and/or pull/push carts during the Championship Proper. The use of automotive transportation is **NOT** permitted. TPC Boston caddies may be available for the championship proper. Please contact the golf shop at (508) 285-9874 to secure a caddie for the championship proper.

Starting Times – Rounds 1, 2 & 3: Can be found on the [Massachusetts Open](#) home page. Please make sure to be at your starting tee at least **10 minutes** prior to your starting time to ensure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

A shuttle will be available from the golf shop/practice putting green to the 1st tee, please plan your time accordingly.

Practice Facilities: Will be open and available starting at 6:30am each day.

Food & Beverage: Will be available for purchase throughout the event in the clubhouse and at the 10th Tee (cash and/or credit); there is no ATM on-site.

- Lunch service will be available starting at 10:30am and will end approx. 30-45 minutes after each round. Bar service will also be available.

Locker Room: The locker room facilities will be open/available for all competitors; no locker space will be available.

Parking: To assist with parking availability, please plan accordingly with caddies, friends, family, etc. and carpool if possible.

Purse/Prizes: The Clarence G. Cochrane Memorial Trophy will be presented to the Champion and The Commonwealth Cup will be presented to the Low-Amateur. A professional purse of \$75,000 will be distributed to the low fifty (50) finishers & ties. Merchandise certificates will be awarded to amateur finishers and are only redeemable at the host site.
